ABSTRACT CRITERIA

Oral and Poster Presentations are Accepted!

- English language abstracts will only be accepted
- Do not contain images or figures in the abstract
- Only eligible to those who are/were at an Albertan post-secondary institution
- Abstract *body*: maximum 350 words
- Abstract *title*: maximum 20 words
- Abstract *format*: background, objective, methods, results, conclusions
- List all authors (supervisors, etc.)
- Can submit works in progress
- A maximum of one oral and one poster will be offered to each presenting author
